### 10th World Fence Building Championship in Schönbronn

Fence Building – This sport has long been a favourite New Zealand and Australia. In Europe, Schönbronn, in Germany, has been the location of the World Championship for a number of years now, and 2008 will once again provide an exciting contest for this unusual activity.

On Sunday, 17<sup>th</sup> August, starting at 10:00 A.M., the World Championship will celebrate its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary. After several years of the favoured New Zealanders taking the prize back to the home of professional fence building, the German fence builders demonstrated their skill at the 2006 Championship by winning and forcing the New Zealand champ, Owen Petersen, into third place.

Eight fence building experts from New Zealand, Austria, Switzerland, Holland, France, Denmark, Poland and Germany will fight for the title of champion this year. New Zealand's current champion, Paul van Beers, will give his all to try to take the title back to New Zealand once again.

Throughout this exciting competition, the competitors will display their skills in speed of installation, wire and wood fabrication, and fence assembly, while being evaluated by an international team of judges.

In addition to this, a model fence displaying the numerous features of the PATURA Electric Fencing Programme will be on hand. This will clearly demonstrate the operational and troubleshooting features of an electric fence.
